## Crime Prevention Tips

Officer Jerry Heid of the Baltimore Police Department offers these tips to help you prevent crime this holiday season and throughout the year.

- Be aware of the image you project. Always walk with confidence and purpose.
- Try to make positive, friendly eye contact with the people you pass on the street. Look well ahead and try to avoid any confrontation before you come face to face with it.
- When shopping, don't carry too many packages. This makes you vulnerable to theft.
- Never flash large sums of money or credit cards. Don't walk down the street talking on a mobile phone either because you are advertising to a thief that you are not paying attention and that you have something of value.
- If you carry a purse, hold it close to your body, preferably in the front. Always keep your purse closed.
- There is safety in numbers. Always try to walk with friends or co-workers on the street.
- If you buy electronic equipment such as a computer, stereo or television, don't advertise to burglars what you have. Put the carton in a dark garbage bag before throwing it in the trash.

## Recycling Information

### Bottle/Can Pick-up: Monday, December 10, 24

Includes glass jars/bottles, aluminum cans, tin (steel) cans, plastic small mouth containers with #1 or #2 on the bottom, empty aerosol cans.

Place the items in blue plastic bags.

### Paper Pick-up: Friday, December 14, 28

Includes newspapers, magazines, phone books, ad mail, cardboard/boxes, mixed paper, scrap paper.

**Leaf Collection:** every Friday. Bags must be clearly labeled as leaves.

**Bulk Trash:** First Tuesday of the month. You must call 311 at least one week before the date to arrange pick-up.
